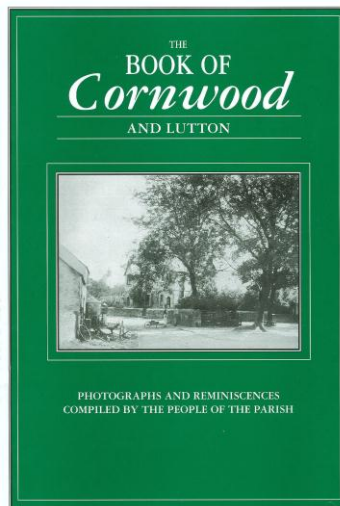


The Book of Cornwood and Lutton

The Book of Cornwood and Lutton, published in 1997 by residents of the parish, is now out of print. Many people over the past few years have asked me whether it was possible to obtain a copy. Recently I endeavoured to get it scanned and made available in electronic form but my efforts were thwarted. The reasons are not important but, in the end, the publisher, **Halsgrove Publishing, Media and Distribution**, indicated that they were prepared to make it available again.

In a recent email message to me **Simon Butler**, the Publisher, said:

"Things have moved on since we last corresponded and we are indeed making the Community History series available online as they fall out of print. This is done partly in order to keep the Community History Series as a coherent body of work within the Halsgrove list whilst preserving the rights of the authors under the existing contract. Each book is being scanned or re-created in digital form as requests are received. So far we have no enquiries for the Cornwood book but we'd be happy to respond to any we do receive in future."

Members of the original Cornwood Parish Map Project Group, who hold the copyright, have also told me they would like to see the book made available to the public again and support this undertaking. It may take more than a few requests to actually get the book scanned so I am canvassing interested people in order to make the case to Halsgrove.
